E Comp Mike was Exalted in to the HRA in 2003 with St John's Chapter 3972, progressing and becoming MEZ of St John's in 2013. He became its Scribe E in 2015. He joined Royal Air Force Chapter 7335 (London) in 2009, became its MEZ in 2003 followed by Scribe E in 2014. E Comp Mike was appointed ProvAGSE in 2016 and ProvGSE in 2019. He was appointed PAGDC in the Craft in 2013.
