The Travelling Gavel

The Travelling Gavel was presented to Loyal Lodge by Worshipful Brother Robert Proctor and St Martin's Lodge Chatham Massachusetts in 1996, the year after Loyal Lodge 251 twinned with St Martin's. WBro Bob Proctor and WBro Roger Chapple were the respective Masters the year before. The twinning ceremony went well, after a Third Degree on the same night (someone thought it would be a good idea for St Martin's to see 'how we did it'!) and in the presence of the entire executive of the Province (save one Assistant Provincial Grand Master), and WBro Roger's first ceremony after his installation! Also in keeping with St Martin's tradition WBro Bob wore a top hat throughout the Ceremony!

When presented the Gavel, (which is some three feet long) had a note of the Travelling Gavel Rules displayed on a small engraved rigid plastic notice hung around the shaft by a small chain. It was suggested the Gavel should stay within the Province of Devonshire but it soon travelled far and wide and very quickly we had no idea where it was.

WBro Bob Proctor's eyesight is now failing but he still attends St Martins Lodge meetings as often as he can and he remains an Honorary Member of Loyal Lodge 251. Once again the Secretaries of both Lodges are exchanging information and Summonses.
